

**Revelation Study**  
**Vision 3**  
**The New Song and The Reaping**  
**Revelation 14:1-20**

- I. A Final Appeal During The Days of the Beast from the Earth
  - A. The saints are also marked
  - B. They sing a “new song” of redemption
  - C. A message of strong warning about the impending judgment and the nature of the beast is presented
  - D. Christ returns in power, to save and to judge
- II. The 144,000 and Their New Song (1-5)
  - A. We have already identified the 144,000 as all the saints of God
  - B. They are marked out in a similar fashion as the “people of the beast”
  - C. Their voice sounds like the voice of Christ (a call again to proper witness)
  - D. Their song is a song only for the redeemed
  - E. “Not defiled by women” – spiritual purity
    - 1. Cf. 2 Kings 19:21; Isaiah 37:22; Jeremiah 14:17; 18:13; 31:4, 13, 21; Lamentations 1:15; 2:13; Amos 5:2)
    - 2. Cf. 2 Corinthians 11:2; Revelation 19:7-9; 21:2
    - 3. Included is their commitment (follow), their redemption (purchased), their declaration of truth (no lie), and their new righteousness (blameless).
- III. One Last Chance (6-13)

- A. The eternal gospel – God’s message has not changed
- B. What is the total message of the angels collectively?
  - 1. Fear, glorify, and worship God
  - 2. His judgment is coming/has come
  - 3. The Beast is Fallen
  - 4. Participation in the City of Man receives the wrath of God (everlastingly)
  - 5. A promise of hope for those persevering in the faith
- IV. The Reaping (14-20)
  - A. This is the Second Coming
  - B. Jesus has come to:
    - 1. Gather all his people in the glorious resurrection
    - 2. To judge those that have lived in rebellion against the grace of God and the gospel of Jesus
    - 3. This judgement is exercised “outside of the city”
